

WRITING A LAW REFORM SUBMISSION DEFINITION

EDO (Qld) – Writing effective law reform submissions – current as at July about the proposed change and give examples where necessary.

Any previous submissions made on the same or similar topics. What information should you include in your submission? If so, set out your story to the Department or Committee using a real or hypothetical example. For example when a government official is given the power to make decisions, is that power clearly defined and able to be reviewed or appealed? If you feel really strongly about the issue and your submissions are ignored, consider calling the contact person to arrange a meeting to discuss the matter in person. Note that submissions are often made public but it is possible to provide your submission anonymously. See here for example. Appeal rights and further action Do I have rights if my submission is disregarded? If your submission is lengthy, summarise your key points at the beginning or end of your submission so that your primary concerns are highlighted. It is likely the agency will not change its entire policy approach, particularly at a Parliamentary Committee stage, but you can still get important details altered to better protect the environment. Consider alternative solutions Do you think there are better ways of achieving positive outcomes? It may be helpful to mark on the paper the sections you agree with and those you disagree with so you can easily refer back to them. How should you prepare for your submission? Your views matter and they have the ability to influence and shape government initiatives. It is however important that you get involved early in the policy making process and work with the Government in trying to protect the environment. If so, make sure you set out any alternative ideas for the Department or Committee to consider. Be sure to keep your submissions concise and clear. Do not delve into information that you do not know about. Register on our website bottom of the page. Unfortunately, you have no legal grounds for an appeal if your submission is dismissed or the points you have made are not adopted in full. Read more about the FLPs and what a breach might involve here. The final date for making a submission will vary depending on the project. Supporting documents may be attached. If there is not enough room or you wish to make submissions beyond the template questions, you can also add an annexure. Further, if you would like to discuss your views or gather support for your submission, consider contacting your local State or Federal member, as appropriate. Explain your experience in this matter e. However, if your submission is made to a parliamentary committee, you cannot release your submission until after the committee authorises its release to the public. Be sure to maintain a professional and moderate tone. At the end of the public submission period, the committee will usually place your submission and others on its own website, so, you can link to that once it is up. Those are different meanings for the word submission. Public contributions to a review are called submissions. Does it provide for a transparent process which enables public participation and scrutiny of decision-making? What should you not include in your submission? It is also a good idea to use case studies or hypothetical examples to support each of your recommendations. Check the deadline and address for your submission. Join us!
